## Reverse Vending Machines

Recycle used plastic drink bottles and aluminum drink cans in the Reverse Vending Machines. These machines are able to identify, sort and collect the empty bottles and cans.

## E-Waste

- **19,772.5 kg** of e-waste collected in ALBA E-Waste Bins (July 2022 to June 2023)



## Trees

- **46,000** trees
- 1,000 more trees will be planted in the next two years



## LED Lights

- **97%** of lights in common areas replaced with LED bulbs
- LEDs offer the same brightness, use half the power and last twice as long compared to fluorescent bulbs, and they can be recycled too



## Rooftop Solar Panels

- **256** of 275 blocks installed
- Savings of about **23 million kg** of CO<sub>2</sub> emissions



## Community Gardens

- **36** gardens
- Part of the Town's efforts to increase common green spaces and allow residents to bond through a shared love for gardening

## Flyer Recycling Bins

- **70** bins placed conveniently near letterboxes for easy and tidy disposal of junk mail
- **1.2 kg** of recyclables per bin collected monthly

## Smart and Sustainable Tengah

Tengah in Hong Kah North will be the first HDB town to be fully integrated with its surrounding natural environment.

The Biophilic Town Framework emphasises a nature-centric community with nature at its doorstep, complemented by a car-free Town Centre.

Smart technologies, including solar panels, centralised cooling, environmental simulations and a waste conveyance system, make green living accessible.

## Sungei Buloh Wetland Reserve

Sungei Buloh Wetland Reserve, Singapore's first ASEAN Heritage Park, spans 202 hectares and boasts a diverse ecosystem of mangroves, mudflats, ponds and forests. This haven of rich biodiversity is vital for migratory birds and showcases myriad flora and fauna.

## Sembcorp Tengah Floating Solar Farm



Singapore's first major floating solar system on the Tengah Reservoir. With 122,000 solar panels across 10 solar floating panel islands, it can power about 16,000 four-room HDB flats annually.



## MRT Seats Upcycling

Seats upcycled from retired MRT trains were placed in CCK Town as part of the sustainability initiative, Action for Green Towns, a collaboration between SMRT and 15 PAP Town Councils.

## Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Points

With the shift to electric cars – which generate 50% less carbon emissions than internal combustion engine cars – more EV charging points are being introduced in HDB carparks. CCK Town currently has 11 such points, with more in the pipeline.
